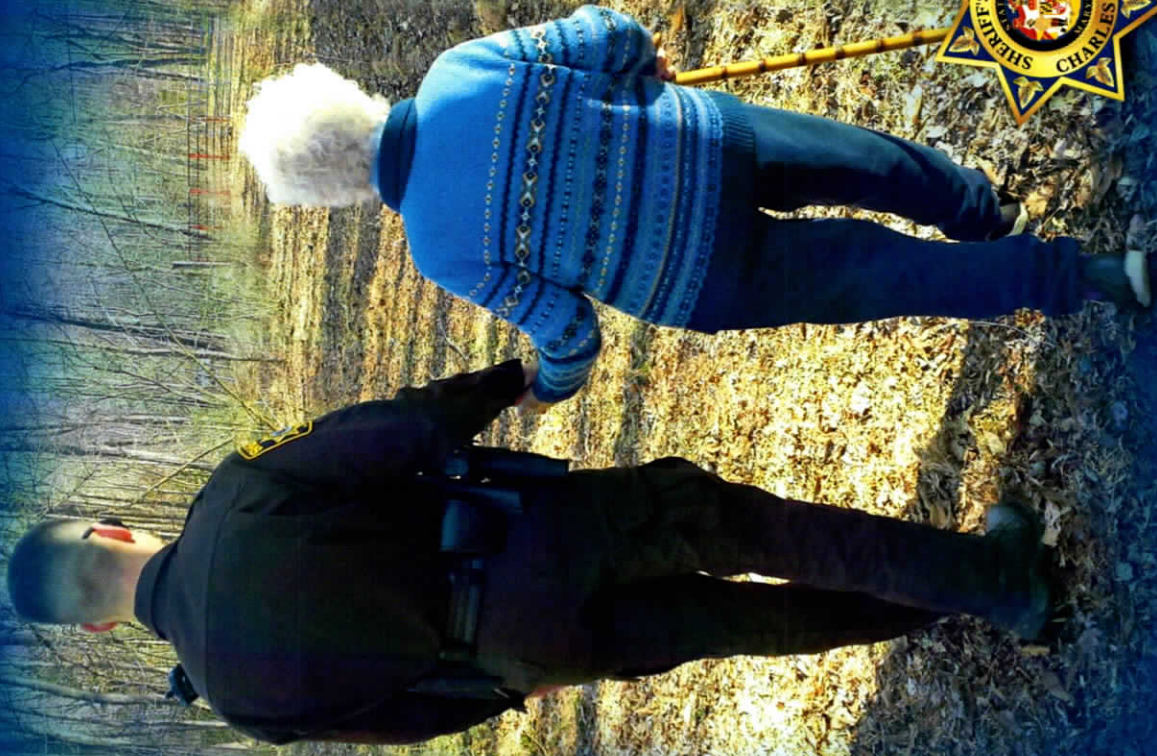

- Provide emotional support and guidance following a traumatic event, during an investigation, or after an arrest
- Help explain victim's rights and the processes of the criminal justice system
- Provide contact information and agency referrals for appropriate local, statewide, and national support services
- Assist with providing emergency needs
- Guide victims to appropriate financial resources
- Guide victims to notification services
