7. Always have a parent check your treats before you eat them

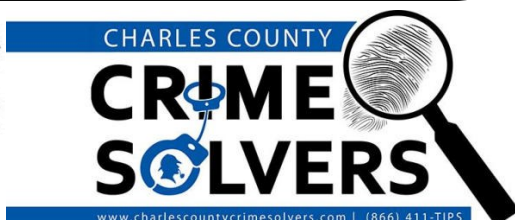
DID YOU KNOW?
