The Charles County Teen Court Code of Conduct (below) is strictly enforced. Please review prior to completing your application. Please do not submit an application if you are not prepared to fully comply with the code of conduct.

Behavior & Protocol

Teen Court participants should arrive by 5:15 p.m. and sign in with the Teen Court Coordinator or other Teen Court staff members as directed. Participants will follow the directions of the Teen Court staff and are expected to display appropriate behaviors at all times, which includes being courteous and respectful, maintaining an acceptable demeanor, and refraining from the use of obscene language or gestures. There is to be no eating, drinking, or gum chewing in the courtroom. Smoking in or outside the building is strictly prohibited. Running in the hallways or wandering through the building is not permitted. During Teen Court proceedings, participants are expected to pay attention, refrain from private conversations, and avoid laughing and making loud noises. Once the hearing has begun, participants will not be allowed to leave the courtroom. Teen court participants should not display facial expressions, nodding or shaking of heads, or other conduct that might indicate personal feelings or opinions about what is happening during the proceedings. These are real cases and deviation from the expected norms of the program will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the program. Finally, all questions and concerns should be directed to the Teen Court Staff.

Cell Phone & Electronics Policy

You are allowed to have your cell phone with you on Teen Court nights. However, once you enter into the courthouse the cell phone must be powered off.

Dress

All participants are expected to wear appropriate attire. Males should wear pants and collared shirts or sweaters. Females should wear pants, skirts or dresses that reach at least fingertip length (school regulation). Good grooming and hygiene is expected. **If dress code is not followed you will be asked to leave or you may be allowed participate but will not receive any credit for that night's participation.**
