Adult Volunteer Positions



COMMUNITY JUDGE

Oversees the Courtroom and helps guide everyone through the process.

Qualifications:

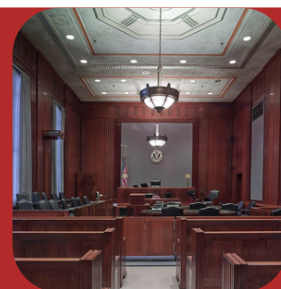
- Complete training with Teen Court Coordinator
- Hold Court Monitor position for minimum of 6 months
- Must be at least 25 years old

COURT MONITOR

Supervises the jury and helps guide them through the process.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 23 years old
- Must shadow the position for a minimum of 4 sessions



EXIT INTERVIEWER

Explains the sanctions to the respondent and family after the trial. Aids in completing necessary paperwork.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 23 years old
- Must shadow the position for a minimum of 3 sessions

EXIT INTERVIEWER ASSISTANT

Assists Exit Interviewer with preparing paperwork for families.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 21 years old
- Must shadow the position for a minimum of 3 sessions



CASE REVIEW ASSISTANT

Aids respondents in completing written sanctions during Teen Court Sessions.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 23 years old
- Must shadow the position for a minimum of 3 sessions
