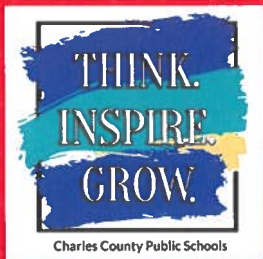

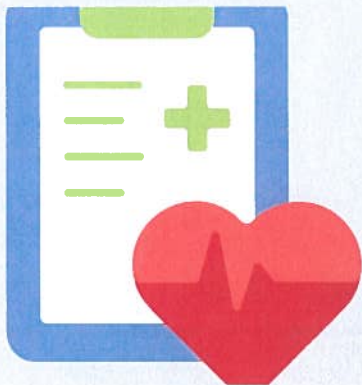

What is a School-based Health center (SBHC)?

A health clinic on the campus of Indian Head Elementary School that provides health services to CCPS students during school hours. Services provided include: Sick visits, physicals, well-check visits, health education, and more!

Who is eligible to visit the SBHC?

Students enrolled in Charles County Public Schools can also enroll in the School-Based Health Center to receive services. **To enroll your student, simply fill out the enrollment forms on the website (QR Code Below) or enroll in person at the clinic!**



What if my child already has a doctor?

The SBHC does not replace a student's doctor, but can provide a convenient option for sick visits during school hours. The SBHC can communicate with your student's doctor so they remain aware of any care your student receives.
